SQUIRREL

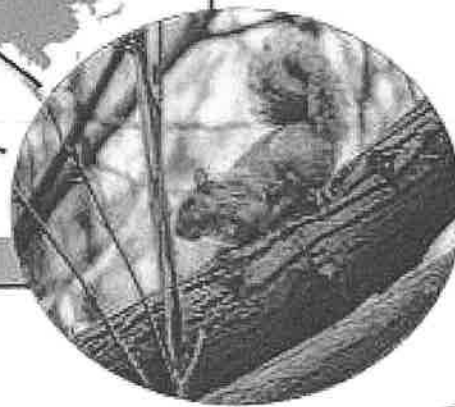
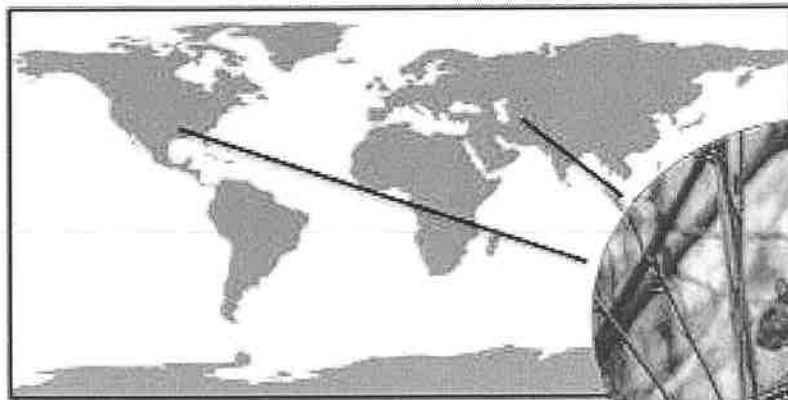

Lifespan - They can live from 6 years to 20

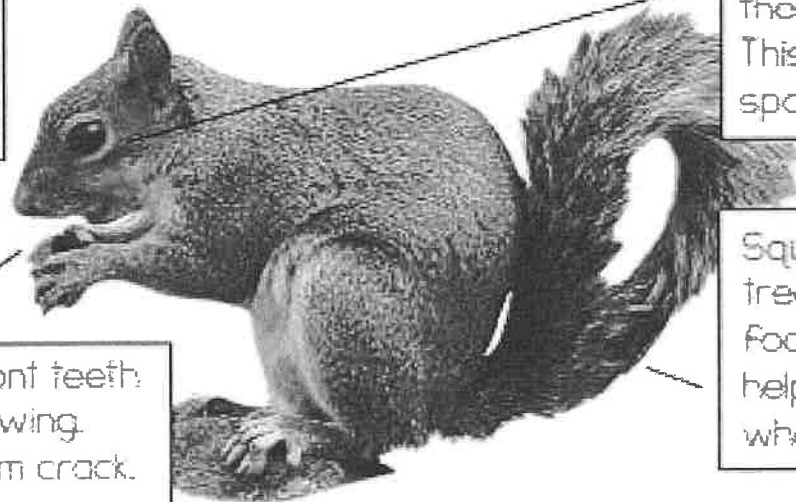


SQUIRRELS ARE GREAT GATHERERS
