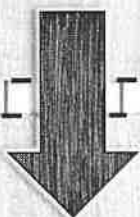

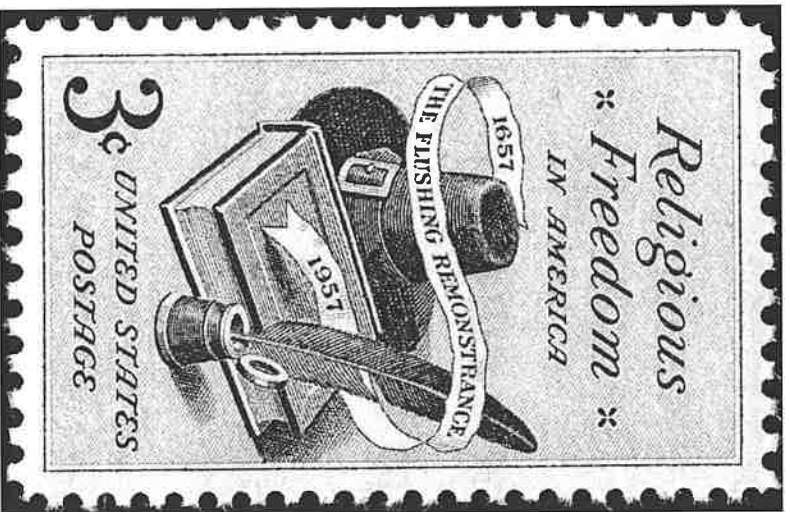

- **Creativity**

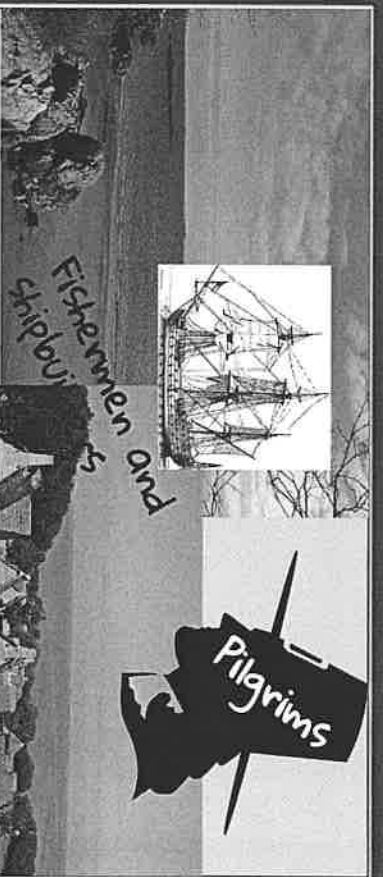
You will find one slide with a blank stamp outline. This is where you will create your commemorative stamp. Be sure to use the rubric and check to make sure you have included everything before you submit it.
