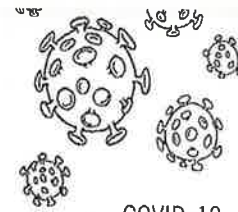

## Bell Schedule

The district will follow an abbreviated bell schedule for the first six weeks of school. The format of the school day in October and beyond will be communicated at a later date and will be based on ISBE's recommendation.

## Meal Information

Breakfast will be Grab-n-Go before school each morning. Lunches will be Grab-n-Go immediately following the end of the school day. Lunches will not be served during the traditional lunch/study hall hours.

## Health & Safety

### Signs & Symptoms

Parents are responsible for keeping their child home if they show any signs of COVID-19 including but not limited to fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, fatigue, muscle and body aches, headache, sore throat, nausea, or vomiting. Signs of COVID-19 during the school day will be sent to the quarantine nursing station.

### Masks

Masks will be required of all staff and students at all times.



## Student Attendance and Bell Schedule

In order to meet the requirements of ISBE given our enrollment, students will be assigned an attendance group based on their last name regardless of grade level. Student divisions will be as follows:

- **A Day** - Students with the last names "A" through "L"
- **B Day** - Students with the last names "M" through "Z"
- **C Day** - PreK students and all students will have intervention opportunities.

## Transportation Information

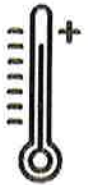
Students arriving at school must enter one of the following doors based on their transportation.

**Please Note:** All other entrances into the building will be locked.

- **MECC**
  - Bus riders enter and exit out the west doors of the Mornence Junior High building.
  - Car Riders are to drop-off or pick-up at the Southeast doors (Door #5S) of the school. Parents please form one line in the parking lot along the east side of the building.
  - Walkers are to drop-off or pick-up at the Southeast doors (Door #5S) of the school.
- **Je-Neir**
  - Bus riders will enter and exit through the main entrance. (door 3N)
  - Car riders will enter and exit through the west door. (door 4W)
  - Walkers will enter and exit through the northeast door. (door 1N)
- **MJHS**
  - Bus riders enter and exit out the west doors of the Mornence Junior High building.
  - Car riders will enter and exit through the main doors on the north side of the building.
  - Walkers will enter and exit through the main doors on the north side of the building.
- **MCHS**
  - All students and visitors will enter and exit through the main entrance of the high school

### Temperature Checks

All students will have their temperature taken upon arrival. Students who show symptoms or with temperatures above 100.4 degrees will be sent home after a parent is contacted.



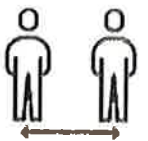
### School Sanitation

Classrooms and equipment will have disinfecting wipes for personal cleaning of student and staff desks, and workstations. Hand sanitizers are available in each classroom as well. Common areas will be disinfected with a 30-day residual application. All horizontal surfaces will be cleaned with Virex.



### Social Distancing

Students and staff will maintain social distance of 6 feet from one another when possible.
